### 2012 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS, CLASSES, DINNERS



**Bay Leaf Cottages Volunteer Weekends** – join in the spring clean-up and summer preparations. Stay two nights free in our motel, work Saturday-Sunday helping with painting/yard work (continental breakfast provided daily), and receive a voucher for two nights free lodging during the 2012 season. **May 4-6<sup>th</sup>, May 18-20<sup>th</sup>**



**Traditional Chinese Arts & Crafts Classes** – artisan developed hands-on arts & crafts focusing on the time-honored methods. A variety of projects are available, each taking between 45-60 min. to complete and costing \$6.00 per craft (this covers our cost of materials and shipping to the US). Reservations required: 207-505-0458. Minimum age: 5. Children under age 8 must be accompanied by a parent. Sessions open to local residents and travelers. Options include: Kite-making, lantern-making, puppet-making, seal carving, inner bottle painting, calligraphy on Chinese fan, Peking opera masks, and more. Note: Artisans who have provided materials are each in their 80s and senior level artists in Beijing. **Sunday afternoons from 3-5 p.m. on May 6<sup>th</sup>, May 20<sup>th</sup>, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, June 24<sup>th</sup>, July 22<sup>nd</sup>, and August 12<sup>th</sup>.** Note: Groups and parties can be scheduled for additional days/times.

**Chinese Home-style Cooking Classes** - make cold and hot dishes typical of regional cuisines in China just like people would cook at home using fresh produce and special sauces. Classes are Sundays evenings from 5-7:00 p.m. Minimum 4 persons, maximum 12. Cost per adult: \$12.00, children ages 9 and up \$6.00. These are very “family-friendly” hands-on classes. **June 3<sup>rd</sup>, July 22<sup>nd</sup>, August 12<sup>th</sup>**

**Cooking Class Dinners ~ Maine Seafood Basics** join us at the Bistro for these hands-on cooking classes that includes your dinner. Make dishes using local seafood and produce. Minimum 4 persons, maximum 12. (Bring your own wine or beer for dinner.) Cost per person \$25.00. Classes begin at 3:30 p.m. Each class will be offered twice in 2012:

*MSB IV. Seafood Salads and "Rolls" (such as Lobster Roll) – June 30<sup>th</sup> & August 4<sup>th</sup>*

*MSB V. Seafood Side Dishes & Entrees – July 7<sup>th</sup> & August 11<sup>th</sup>*
