



Reunion and Group Arrangements with Bay Leaf Cottages

We welcome your group to schedule a program anytime between May 1 and October 31st. Should you elect to come during the annual Lobster Festival (first week in August), the lodging rates will be higher.

We have 11 cottages and 9 motel rooms available. They sleep from 2-6 persons. The breakdown is: 2 persons (3 cottages), 3 persons (4 cottages and 1 motel room), 4 persons (2 cottages and 7 motel rooms), 5 persons (1 motel room) and 6 persons (1 cottage). Each cottage has convenience appliances (refrigerator, microwave, coffee pot, toaster) with 7 cottages having full kitchens. Each motel room has a refrigerator, coffee pot, and cable TV.

We also have meeting areas, bistro, outdoor picnic tables, and plenty of tables/chairs to set up for group seating.

We are able to provide hands-on arts & crafts for kids, teen programs, adult seminars and speakers about a wide range of topics. In addition, Bay Leaf Cottages can arrange for local area programs. Please include on the schedule how you would like your Reunion Event to be arranged.

Activities and Options:

Chinese Traditional Arts & Crafts or Storytelling with Activity (artisan designed in China) @ \$5.00 per child/item (We would select age-appropriate arts/crafts - kites, lanterns, inner bottle painting, fan painting, calligraphy, knotting, Chinese traditional games, Peking Opera masks, Monkey King, and more!)

Maine-Themed Arts & Crafts or Storytelling with Activity @ \$5.00 per child/item. Activities include Lighthouses, Marine Life, Maine animals, etc.

Teen Programs - arts/crafts, seminars, activities - usually \$10-15.00 per activity or actual - such as bike rental/ferry fee for an Islesboro bike ride.

Hidden Valley Camp Day for ages 8-16 @ \$75.00 per child/teen

Adult Seminars/Workshops @ \$20.00 per adult - Just let us know what you're interested in.

Special Guest Speakers - actual (usually cost is transportation and stipend) - we can work with you if you have a theme in mind or program desired.

Local Area Attractions -Lincolnville Beach, Islesboro Ferry, Lobster fishing, kayaking, biking, shopping in Camden, Camden Harbor, Penobscot Maritime Museum, Owl's Head Lighthouse, Marshall Point Lighthouse, Farnsworth Museum, Puffin Cruises, Marine Life Cruises, Schooner Cruise, Acadia National Park, Camden Hills State Park, Cellardoor Winery, Owl's Head Transportation Museum, Ardemere Farms (Oreo Cows), local artisans and galleries and much more!

Meals on-site - We offer Maine Lobster Dinners for \$12 per adult/teen, \$8 per child eating lobster and \$5 per child not eating lobster. BBQ lunches and dinners are \$10 per adult, \$8 per teen/child 12 and up, \$5 per child ages 4-11. A wide variety of food options are available. Cooking Classes are \$20 per person. Eating the food from the cooking class is \$3.00 per person (includes beverages).
